July 2012 Bellingham Film Festivals partners with the Pickford Film Center in Bellingham, WA

August 2012 Bellingham Film Festival partners with local film makers, Langley West and Gary Washington, to begin planning the first horror film festival in Bellingham called Bleedingham.

September 2012 Bellingham Film Festival partners with Washington State Studio Network (WSSN)

September 2012 Bellingham Film Festivals partners with The Black Box Theatre in Edmonds, WA

October 2012 Bleedingham, the first Bellingham Film Festival, is produced, premiers, and sells out.

November 2012 WSSN tours the Bleedingham Film Festival at The Black Box Theatre in Edmonds, WA.

March 2013 Bellingham Film Festival teams up with WSSN to create quarterly Film Showcases to help bring awareness to the local filming communities.

April 2013 Bellingham Film Festival helped a local production company find dancers for an epic music video dance scene to be shot in Bellingham.

April 2013 Bellingham Film Festivals teamed up with Gather to give away free tickets to the first film in their summer spring series.

May 2013 Bellingham Film Festivals teamed up with UWTV Channel 27 to help collect films for their summer weekly series called Backstory: "The Filmmaker's Vision."

June 2013 Bellingham Film Festivals is contacted by the American Alpine Club and 5 Point Film Festival to help collect submissions for their film festival that will be touring Bellingham end of August 2013.

July 2013 Bellingham Film Festivals successfully runs the second WSSN Film Showcase: Summer Edition. Doubling the number of submissions and tripling the number of ticket sales.

July 2013 Bellingham Film Festivals teams up with Gather again to give away free tickets to the first film in their summer film series.

August 2013 Bellingham Film Festivals teams up with Washington Filmworks to organize a mixer and info session in Bellingham at the next WSSN Film Showcase in November.

September 2013 After building the foundation for the Bleedingham Film Festival, the festival has been handed over to the community to continue to grow and develop, while BFF will begin planning other festival formats to continue to provide opportunities for film makers to show their work and practice their skill.

October 2013 BFF worked with Makeshift to help supply props for their haunted house.

November 2013 BFF held the WSSN Film Showcase: Fall 2013 Edition in combination with a film mixer and presentation from Amy Lillard from Washington Film Works.

November 2013 - Bellingham Film Festivals helps Cascade Casting connect with actors and processes their registrations forms.

December 2013 - Film Mixer at the Copper Hog. Drinks sponsored by Hand Crank Films.

March 2014 - Bellingham Film Festivals works with an LA company, All Mods Cons, and Anacortes High School to put together a high school dance for a music video.

May 2014 - Teamed up with Manis Peirre to begin planning the growth of Bellingham Film Festivals.
